VISION



The **Gift of Life** project, in association with Ministry of Health, was supremely successful as 26 children were given free open-heart surgeries, catheterisation lab procedures and other cardiac interventions completely free of charge by the 16-member team from India, USA, Australia & Oman representing the Sri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospital India. It was also a matter of pride for Fiji as the Foundation's **Medical Scholarship Program** came to fruition with the training of Dr. Maryanne Kora'ai at the Sri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospital in Raipur India.

The **Sai Annapoorna** project served over 15,000 meals to the underprivileged and needy families as well as to residents of the various institutions across Fiji. The **Health On Wheels** Medical Outreach Project, in association with Ministry of Health, to the rural villages of Fiji continued to make a significant impact to the health and wellbeing of Fiji's rural population. The **Be a Hero** Project in association with the Fiji National Blood Service was supremely successful as the Foundation won both National and Regional Awards as the highest collectors of blood in Fiji and more importantly, help save thousands of lives. The **Children of God** project of looking after the needs of orphaned children gave us much joy all throughout the year. Project **Heart Beat**, a child heart screening initiative also expanded its work of screening for heart disease.


Our newest project, **One Fiji**, although in its infancy stage, is an opportunity for all Fijians to unite together, serve and help make a difference to the lives of the underprivileged and needy people of Fiji. It has been so encouraging that in its very first initiative, over 500 Volunteers from all walks of life, put their hand up to come and serve.

Finally, we are working hard towards making our dream project a reality – the establishment of South Pacific's first **Children's Heart Hospital** in Suva – providing free Heart Surgeries for the children of Fiji and the Pacific.

I humbly invite all of you who have the same desire to serve, to join our efforts and help us work towards that common good. Let us try to make a difference. Let us do all that we can to inspire change. Like Mahatma Gandhi said, "let us be the change that we wish to see in the world".




