 Every year, approximately 200
children in Fiji and over 2,500 children in the South Pacific are born with Congenital Heart Disease (CHD).

Due to these staggering statistics, Sai Prema Foundation Fiji has opened South Pacific's first Children's free Heart Hospital.  There are no pediatric cardiac
services available in Fiji or any other South
Pacific Island nation.

 The Hospital will provide free Congenital Heart Disease (CHD)
surgeries for the children of Fiji and the South Pacific. There will be NO BILLING COUNTER!

The unavailability, inaccessibility and unaffordability of pediatric cardiac services results in a high number of children dying.

 This is the largest project ever undertaken by a Non-Government Organisation (NGO) in Fiji's history.
